




The Baptism of the Lord is the feast day commemorating the baptism of Jesus in the Jordan River by John the Baptist. Pope Pius XII instituted the commemoration of Jesus' Baptism in 1955. Pope Paul II began a custom of baptizing babies in the Sistine Chapel on this feast day. The Baptism of the Lord also marks the end of the liturgical season of Christmastide. On the following day the season of ordinary time begins.
