Church's Qualifications to be a Baptism Godmother

1. I am female at least 16 years of age.
2. I am a practicing Catholic registered at a parish.
3. I have received the sacraments of Baptism, First Holy Communion and Confirmation in the Catholic Church or have been received into the Catholic Church.
4. I participate in the Mass on Sundays and Holy Days and receive the Sacraments of Eucharist and Reconciliation regularly.
5. If married, I am validly married according to the laws of the Catholic Church. If divorced, I have not remarried outside the Catholic Church.
6. I actively strive to live out my commitment to Christ and to the community life of the Church by my loving response to those with whom I come in contact.

I sign this document to indicate that I fulfill the Catholic Church's requirements of a Godmother, and I commit to this child I will fulfill my responsibilities of a Godmother to the best of my ability.
